<b>Research</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ What is the research question?</li><li>▪ What population will be studied?</li><li>▪ What is the role of the sDOR.2-6y™ in this study?</li><li>▪ What is the planned sample size and power analysis?</li><li>▪ What strategies will be used to recruit subjects?</li><li>▪ What instruments or measures will be included in addition to the sDOR.2-6y™? (Include any psychometric, nutritional, physical, metabolic, and psychological tests.)</li></ul>
<b>Clinical Practice</b>	<p>Approved interventions are those developed, approved or taught by the Ellyn Satter Institute.</p> <p>The distinction between clinical and education interventions is made on the basis of assessment and treatment planning. Unlike an educational intervention, clinical use includes individualized assessment and treatment planning.</p>
<b>Educational Intervention</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ What is the educational setting (e.g. WIC, Head Start, university, extension, primary health care)?</li><li>▪ What is the target audience (e.g., professionals or other staff, participants, students)?</li><li>▪ Indicate ages of the target audience.</li><li>▪ What is the course or program title?</li><li>▪ Explain the scope and focus of the curriculum. Be concrete, i.e. what do you mean by non-dieting, healthy eating, food plans, nutrient focus, etc.</li><li>▪ Indicate that you will NOT be using the sDOR.2-6y™ as part of the course content, i.e. teaching to the test.</li></ul>
<b>Human Subjects Review</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ What are your plans for human subjects review? What agency will you approach for this review?</li></ul>
